Guest Speaker: STAND Youth Panel	STAND Youth members participated in a panel to discuss youth drug trends, COVID-19, and initiatives they feel passionate about in school including mental health and school safety. <u>Highlights:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Youth feel less supported in higher grades. • Mental Health a concern for youth and they don't feel they have the resources or support at school. • Stigma in schools: : "We aren't breaking through the stigma. We are silenced. Stigma is very present in school culture by youth and adults." • School safety needs to be revamped. "We are running away from our problems more than we are addressing/solving them." "We are doing drills for school shootings, but we aren't talking about the real issue and teaching people how to help others, how to be a "buddy, doing real prevention." 	Information

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vaping is prevalent and seen on campus, in bathrooms, and youth are vaping more than tobacco. • “The only way to crack down on the drug issue is to look at the youth themselves. Some kids use for popularity, others need an outlet. A lot of kids don’t know how to handle their feelings; mental health needs to be focused on a lot more.”
