Guest Speaker: Project Opioid Tampa Bay Jennifer Webb	<ul> <li>Project Opioid Tampa Bay – Based on outcomes in Tampa Bay area, Florida Blue initiative that brings attention and brings leaders together to reduce opioid deaths by 2025. Idea to plug holes, absorb risk, business, faith, leadership community and policy makers together. Eight county initiative. How does Pasco County fare? Opioid deaths are higher than in the state and the region, Pinellas has the highest deaths, Pasco is ranked 4<sup>th</sup> highest in the state. Economic impact adds to the argument for loss of life, Costs the nation 1 trillion dollars; 665% increase from 2001 to 2016. Regional costs \$25 billion lost in economic output, lost about 35,000 workers. Pasco up to \$3.18 Billion lost from 1999 to 2015. Project Opioid Tampa Bay objectives: 1. First stakeholder coalition meeting in July, 2. Outreach to raise awareness in the community – launch next year. 3. Preliminary Needs assessment in the community and then moving regional needs assessment, really need to look at those being affected creating equity and assets. Data to be used for members, pulling together unlikely allies, and then helping those who are already working to help. Really looking at the data and then moving from there.
